CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: "CIACC" SCHOLARSHIP

The Department of Accountancy, Faculty of Management and Finance, University of Ruhuna is delighted to call for applications for the "CiACC" Scholarship. This scholarship program is dedicated to assisting students pursuing a specialization in Accounting who may be experiencing financial difficulties while striving to achieve their academic aspirations.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. A full-time student enrolled at BBA in the Accounting degree program.
- 2. The student should not have any record of being accused or found offender of violating the university's laws and regulations throughout their academic tenure.

How to Apply

Interested students must complete the "CiACC Scholarship Application Form" and submit it to the Department of Accountancy, Faculty of Management and Finance, University of Ruhuna on or before 15th November 2023. The following evidence needs to be submitted.

- 1. Duly filled CiACC Scholarship Application Form
- 2. Annual income certified by both the Grama Niladhari and the Divisional Secretariat.
- 3. A personal statement explaining the financial need.
- 4. Other requested documents with CiACC Scholarship Application Form.

Selection Process

A dedicated scholarship selection committee will comprehensively review and evaluate all submitted applications based on the eligibility requirements. The shortlisted candidates are invited for an interview to assess their suitability to receive the scholarship. The selected scholarship recipients will be announced within two weeks after the selection interview.

Scholarship Value and the Duration

A total of six financial scholarships will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd-year Accounting students. The scholarship recipients will be granted a scholarship of Rs. 2,500 per month, disbursed in five instalments over the course of an academic semester, continuing until the completion of the first semester in the 4000 level.

Discontinuation of scholarship

- i. If it is found that the particulars submitted by the applicant are false or inaccurate, the applicant will be disqualified before or during the scholarship period.
- ii. The instalment payments can be discontinued for the students who become an offender or are accused of disciplinary action during the scholarship period.
- iii. The instalment payments can be discontinued for the students who are unable to maintain 80% attendance during the period of the scholarship.
- iv. The instalment payments will be discontinued for the students who engage in an internship or any other employment during the period of the scholarship.
- v. The Department of Accountancy has the authority to discontinue the scholarship program at any time due to unavoidable situations.

Important Notes

- The CiACC Scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to deserving students, thereofor please ensure that the application reflects the genuine financial situation.
- Scholarship recipients are expected to submit an academic progress report every six month.
- We encourage eligible students to apply for the CiACC Scholarship and take advantage of this opportunity to alleviate financial barriers to their education.
